- \$4 each 11x14 canvas panels


- 1. (Three) 11 X 14 canvas panels
- 2. Odorless or low odor clear mineral spirits, no turpentine! (Home Depot has it)
- 3. Artist's palette I recomend the "Richeson Grey Matters Palette Pad 12x16". ------
- 4. A roll of 2-ply paper towels.
- 5. #2 pencil.
- 6. Small metal trowel palette knife.



7. Jar with good lid (for cleaning brushes)



Large jam or spaghetti sauce jars are good. Jar needs to hold at least 16 oz, better if 24 oz.





8. As far as buying the right paint brushes for the class you will need to buy them from me (\$60 for the set). Students buying their own brushes in the past has lead to many problems.
