

BEGINNERS PAINTING CLASS SUGGESTED SUPPLY LIST

PLEASE BRING THE SUPPLIES YOU ALWAYS WORK WITH. ANY COLORS OR BRUSHES ARE ADEQUATE. THIS IS SIMPLY SUGGESTIONS FOR THOSE WHO DO NOT HAVE MUCH IN THE WAY OF SUPPLIES OR WOULD LIKE TO TRY SOMETHING NEW.

ACRYLIC, HIGH FLOW ACRYLIC, FLUID ACRYLIC, HEAVY BODY ACRYLIC &/or WATERCOLOR PAINT COLORS:

I work exclusively with Golden Artist Colors Inc. which makes acrylic paints as well as watercolor paint called QoR watercolors. Golden makes introductory sets of each of these paints that allow for a good introduction to the paint and can start your paint palette off with a nice variety of useful colors. Feel free to bring any/all paints you wish to work with, professional level paint is preferred.

PRIMARY SUGGESTED PALLETTE: Cad Yellow, Cad Orange, Cad Red, Prussian Blue, Dioxazine Purple, Sap Green, Burnt Umber, Carbon Black, Titanium White

OTHER SUGGESTED COLORS: Green Gold, Phthalo Turquoise, Quinacridone Magenta, Colbalt Teal, Indigo, Quinacridone Gold, Burnt Sienna

CANVAS:

Pre-stretched canvases of any brand and of any size are welcomed to begin the paintings

PAPER:

I work exclusively with Canson paper

300lb cold press paper sheets

140lb paper pads can be used for paintings

Feel free to bring paper tablets of any size or brand of paper you prefer

BRUSHES:

IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO BUY THESE BRUSHES - SIMPLY SUGGESTIONS

I exclusively use Trekell Brushes

Some form of a liner or signature brush in a size 0 or thinner if you prefer even finer detail

Some form of a mop brush in a size 1 or 2

Some form of a dagger brush to make beautiful lines (any size is acceptable)

Various sizes of flat square brushes are ideal

A large house painting brush or varnish brush is also ideal for covering large surfaces

Palette knives of varying sizes are optional

PALETTE:

Please use whatever you have or prefer, a white enamel tray is fine or any airtight palette box can also work well.

I use the metal tin palette that comes with my QoR watercolor paints.

WATER:

I use a travel water cup that bends flat once empty but any cup to hold your water is acceptable.

ADDITIONAL SUPPLY SUGGESTIONS:

Painters Tape

Ruler

A set of chalk pastels

Collaging papers to include in paintings

Water spray bottle

Roll of Paper Towels

Hair Dryer

Smock or Apron to protect clothing
